ANNUAL MEETING & BEYOND CHAMPAGNE TASTING

Sunday May 19 is the date of the Society's Annual Meeting. The meeting will be brief and is FREE to all Society members. However, if you want to stay for the tasting afterward, you will need to pay online or send in your check for the event.

Everyone is familiar with French Champagne and know that it is a little on the expensive side. A bottle of ordinary Champagne runs around \$50 with the premium wines in the \$200 — \$300+ price range.

France also produces some amazing sparkling wines in other regions by the same method used in Champagne. By law, because they are not produced in the Champagne region, they cannot legally be called Champagne. These wines are officially known as *Crémant*.

The regulations governing the production of *Crémant* are almost as strict as those for Champagne. Grapes must be hand-harvested; whole bunch pressed; have sugar content in a specific range; with the second fermentation in the bottle; a minimum of 9 months aging on the lees with disgorging after aging; and only the specified grape varieties permitted for that region.

There are 8 regions where *Crémant* wines are made in France. For the tasting, we have selected wines from 4 of the most important regions: *Crémant de Bourgogne*; *Crémant d'Alsace*; *Crémant di Limoux*; *and Crémant de Loire*. These will be tasted side-by-side and compared to a fine Champagne that retails for \$90. The *Crémants* in this tasting, on the other hand, retail from \$17 to \$24.
