Join us for a celebration — end of the 2021 Washington wine grape harvest. We will journey through a special selection of Northwest wines, and Rob Griffin, founder and winemaker at Barnard Griffin will discuss this year's harvest and the challenges it presented.

The event will feature an outstanding selection of 7 fine wines. For the reception wine, we will serve a Treveri Cellars Blanc de Blanc NV Brut sparkling wine. This will be followed by 3 flights of 2 wines each, with each flight perfectly paired with a wonderful food selection.

The first flight features 2 white wines: a 2019 Barnard Griffin Côte du Rôb Blanc and a 2019 CAVU Cellars Sauvignon Blanc. These will be accompanied by a savory charcuterie tray that includes cheese, meat, crackers, crostini, olives and nuts.

The second flight features a 2018 Oregon Pinot Noir from Archery Summit and a Gordon Estate 2017 Tempranillo. These wines will be

served with a Ukrainian lamb stew and butternut squash *arancini di riso* with a white wine sauce.

The third flight features a 2019 Upchurch LTL Merlot and a 2018 Bartholomew Reciprocity that is a 50% Carménère and 50% Cabernet Sauvignon blend. These are accompanied by marinated beef skewers with *chimichurri* sauce and a special Ukrainian *pelmeni* with caramelized onions and bacon.

To finish our afternoon, a Russian cake will be provided with a surprise dessert wine (TBD).
